Health Requirements for Students Entering Grade 7 in Fall of 2017

In accordance with Connecticut State Law, the Wilton Board of Education requires that prior to the opening day of school, an appropriate health examination, including immunization record, be filed in the health office. Prior to August 1, 2017, please submit a State of CT (blue form, HAR-3). Please check to see that all asterisks on the State of CT form are completed by the physician. The Physical must be within 15 months of the first day of entering the 7th grade.

Please pick-up the medications by June 23, 2017. Any medication not picked up will be destroyed after the above date. All controlled medications will be surrendered to the Department of Consumer Protection. Note: Parents of Six Flag students, please pick up meds after the field trip.
